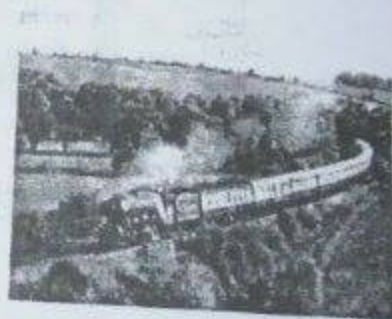

 Each a glimpse and gone for ever!









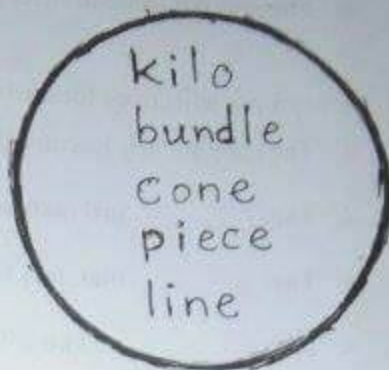

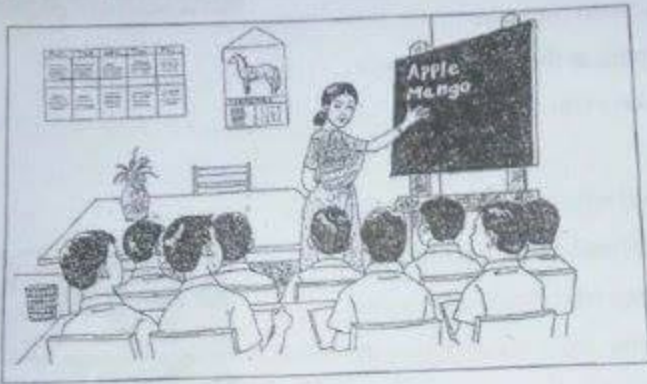
